Financial report 2024

- Maribel Fernandez presents the financial report for the year 2024.
- The account balance at the end of the year is 3603,25€,
- The number of members at the end of the year is 19. Note: we had very few members in 2024 because the registration at CSL2024 did not include EACSL membership. For CSL2025, the membership has been included with registration, so we will have more members in the next year(s).
- From next year there may be sponsor funding (not only the membership fees).
- Accountants for 2024: Stephan Göller is approved as accountant for 2024, together with Christof Löding (approved at the 2024 meeting).
- On the condition that it is approved by the accountants, the financial report is accepted unanimously and the board is released from future liability for the decisions in the report.
- Election of accountants for 2025: Stephan Göller and Christof Löding are approved to continue for 2025 and beyond.

Report on CSL 2025

- 29 PC members, 10 female
- 77 participants in total for the workshops LeaLog Logic Mentoring Workshop
- 79 people registered for CSL, 34 of which were also at the workshops.
- 130 submitted abstracts
- 113 full submissions, with double blind review (one retracted)
- about 3 PC members to each paper, help from 161 external reviewers (providing 178 reviews in total). In total 350 reviews.
- 44 selected papers (one online presentation)
- Proceedings published as in Leibniz International Proceedings in Informatics - 33rd EACSL Annual Conference on Computer Science Logic (CSL 2025)
- Winner of Helena Rasiowa Award for the best student paper at CSL'25:
